

Joining Instructions

Arrival Time

Please arrive 10 minutes before your session starts.

Quad Bikers and **Shotgun Shooters** need to arrive at least **20 minutes before** your session start time.

This will give you time to get checked in and ready for the session.

Location

Our venue is set in private woodland, so has no postcode. Searching for '**Adventure Now**' on most mapping software will take you straight to us.

The only access in is via 'Grange Road', the postcode for this road is M30 8JQ. We are 2 miles away from this postcode so allow 5-10 mins of extra driving time.

Drive to the end of Grange Road, take the left turn over the motorway bridge, you'll see a yellow sign pointing you in the right direction. Keep driving past the farm called 'The Grange'. When you reach the gravel track, **follow the yellow signs** for 2 miles until you see our car park on the right.

If You Are Late

If you are late, you may miss some or all of your session. We will do our best to accommodate latecomers, but sessions need to start and finish on time. If you are not there for the start of the safety briefing, you may have to wait until it is convenient for the instructor to get you started, or you may not be able to start at all.

If you are late for Quad Biking, you may miss the safety brief and the group may leave without you.

No refund or rescheduling will be allowed if you are late or miss your session.

Children

A parent or guardian must always remain with the children in their care. Our instructors cannot supervise children.

In the event you have booked an adult session and bring a child under the age of 18, we may not be able to accommodate them on the session.

What To Wear

Our activities are outdoors, so dress for the weather, bearing in mind the weather can change.

Archery, Crossbows, Air Rifles & Pistol Shooting are all under cover, so you'll not get wet.

Quad Biking, Clay Shooting, Axe Throwing & Angel Throwing have some tree cover, but no roof.

You must not wear open toed shoes or sandals.

Quad Bikers

We require that arms and legs are covered.

We also require a head covering or balaclava to be worn underneath helmets for hygiene reasons. Balaclavas are available to purchase if you don't have your own.

You'll be provided with a helmet, but you're welcome to bring your own. Helmets are compulsory.

Overalls, disposable wellies and gloves are available to hire. These are best purchased in advance, just reply to your booking confirmation to organise this.

Lockers are also available.

Spectators

Unfortunately, spectators are not allowed unless specially arranged.

Dogs are no longer allowed at the venue.
